Insulin Glargine U-100 (Lantus, Basaglar, Semglee)	28 days
Insulin Glargine U-300 (Toujeo Solostar)	56 days
Insulin Detemir (Levemir)	42 days
Insulin Degludec (Tresiba)	56 days
Insulin Glulisine (Apidra)	28 days
Insulin Lispro (Humalog, Admelog, Lyumjev)	28 days
Insulin Lispro; Insulin Lispro Protamine (Humalog Mix 50/50 and 75/25)	10 days
Isophane Insulin (NPH)-Humulin N	14 days
Regular Insulin; Isophane NPH (Humulin 70/30)	10 days
Regular Insulin (Humulin R) U-500	28 days
Insulin Aspart (Novolog)	28 days
Insulin Aspart; Insulin Aspart Protamine (Novolog Mix 70/30)	14 days
Isophane Insulin (NPH)-Novolin N	28 days
Regular Insulin (Novolin R)	28 days
Regular Insulin; Isophane Insulin (NPH) (Novolin 70/30)	28 days

Note: With the exception of Tresiba, all pens should be stored at room temperature once opened. DO NOT refrigerate. Once Tresiba is opened, it may be stored in the refrigerator or at room temperature.
